

SIGMA NU BUILDS

CHAPTER HOUSE

Driscoll Brothers, contractors of this city, have begun work on the new Sigma Nu chapter house on Willard avenue. The architect is Leon Stern of Rochester, N. Y., who was the builder of the new Chamber of Commerce of that city. The cost will be in the neighborhood of \$50,000.

The exterior is to be of dark red brick to the second floor, while the rest will be of English half timber. The roof will be of red tile. The first floor consists of a reception hall, dining room, living room, and kitchens. On the second floor are studies, a billiard room, and an alumni suite. The third floor is given up to dormitories.

The whole building will be fireproof throughout, having all concrete floors, steel beams, and automatic fire doors.

There will be ample room for thirty-four men, for whom the builders will have it ready for occupancy by September, 1911.
